

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

University of Debrecen graduation ceremony

### 1. What is the date and time of the ceremony for the different faculties?

- Faculty of Agricultural and Food Sciences and Environmental Management: **June 26, 2021** (Saturday) from 4 PM
- Faculty of Child and Special Needs Education: **July 10, 2021** (Saturday) from 4 PM
- Faculty of Dentistry: **July 10, 2021** (Saturday) from 4 PM
- Faculty of Economics and Business: **June 26, 2021** (Saturday) from 4 PM
- Faculty of Engineering: **July 10, 2021** (Saturday) from 4 PM
- Faculty of Health: **July 10, 2021** (Saturday) from 4 PM
- Faculty of Humanities: **July 3, 2021** (Saturday) from 4 PM
- Faculty of Informatics: **June 26, 2021** (Saturday) from 4 PM
- Faculty of Law: **June 26, 2021** (Saturday) from 4 PM
- Faculty of Medicine: **July 3, 2021** (Saturday) from 4 PM
- Faculty of Music: **July 3, 2021** (Saturday) from 4 PM
- Faculty of Pharmacy: **July 10, 2021** (Saturday) from 4 PM

### 2. Where will the ceremony take place?

The venue of the event is the Nagyerdei Stadium.

### 3. In line with the effective epidemiological regulations, which documents providing proof of immunity may graduating students use to participate in the ceremony?

- An official certificate (**immunity certificate**) issued in Hungary or abroad is suitable for proving immunity against the coronavirus, which is valid when used together with an ID card or passport
- If a student has already been vaccinated but has no immunity certificate yet, they may prove their immunity with the **mobile app** certifying vaccination against the coronavirus („EESZT alkalmazás”; „EESZT Lakossági”)
- **antigen rapid test** made in Hungary within 48 hours and showing a confirmed negative result

### 4. Which testing place should I get my rapid test from to be able to participate in the event?

We accept a test made by any testing point. We offer help for testing with UD youMed Kft.

On Thursdays and Fridays before each graduation ceremony students can register for a self-financed test.

**6. Which documents providing proof of immunity are not accepted?**

- The vaccination reminder card received after vaccination
- Document issued by a GP about vaccination or claiming that the person cannot be vaccinated
- Document issued by a specialist claiming that the person cannot be vaccinated

**7. Which epidemiological regulations apply to accompanying guests?**

Accompanying guests (relatives, friends, acquaintances) may participate in the event only with an immunity certificate issued in Hungary or abroad, which shall be valid only if used together with an ID card or passport.

**8. Do people under 18 need a certificate providing proof of immunity to participate?**

No. But they should not forget to have an ID card with them to make sure their birth date can be checked.

**9. How can relatives enter the Stadium, where will they sit during the event?**

Using the elevated sidewalk of the Stadium, they should go to the entry gates where the security staff will check their ID, immunity certificate (plastic card) or the mobile app providing proof of immunity, as well as their invitation, after which they can enter the stands opened for them with no reserved seating.

**10. In what form should the invitation be presented?**

- Printed: both color and black and white printing are acceptable, any size is accepted as long as the date, venue of the event and the names of the faculties can be read adequately.
- Electronically: shown on your phone, tablet etc.

**11. Is wearing a mask mandatory?**

As only people with proof of immunity attend the event, wearing a mask is not obligatory after entering the stadium, but, of course, you may use it if you wish.

**12. Can those students also participate in the event who did not graduate this summer?**

Yes they can, but not at the same place where those graduating this summer. They can participate as relatives, friends and watch the event from the stands of the stadium. They also need to show a printed or electronic invitation to enter and also provide proof of immunity similarly to relatives and accompanying guests.

**13. Where can students sign up for the event?**

Students need to register for the event at the Educational Affairs Office of the faculty from which they graduate. Those with majors at two different faculties should sign up at the Educational Affairs Office of the faculty where their main program is offered.



**14. Until when do students need to arrive at the venue?**

By 3:45 PM the latest you need to be sitting on the VIP stands wearing a gown and cap.

**15. When can students pick up their gowns?**

From 2 PM.

**16. Where can students pick up their gowns?**

You can pick up your gown at HALL by the northern events area of the Nagyerdei Stadium. Signs will be posted to help you find the venue.

**17. How can students pick up their gowns?**

After providing proof of immunity in any of the ways listed in point 3 and handing over your ID. You get your ID back after returning the gown.

**18. If I leave my ID there when picking up the gown, how can I identify myself when entering the stadium?**

After picking up the gown, you can move freely within the Stadium.

**19. Until when should students return the gown after the celebration?**

Until 6 PM.

**20. How can students access the VIP stands of the Nagyerdei Stadium?**

After leaving HALL, you turn left and enter through the VIP entrance of the Nagyerdei Stadium. Within the building, you can use the staircase or the elevator to reach the VIP stand. Signs will be posted to help you find the venue.

**21. Will there be a seating plan for students?**

Students will be seated according to the respective faculties and not based on their names. There will be labels on the chairs with the name and color of the faculty and the staff of the faculties will also be there to help.

**22. Will the students be sitting on the assigned chairs throughout the event?**

Yes! During this special event the students will not walk to the podium, will not take over their diploma and there will be no handshakes. Only one person per faculty will symbolically receive a diploma!

**23. What can students take to the stands with them?**

Nothing except for the bottle of mineral water with the university logo on it. Please leave your bags, suitcases with your accompanying guests.

**24. Where can graduating students pick up their bottle of drink (mineral water with the UD logo)?**

In the VIP room of the stadium.



**25. When will the gates of the Nagyerdei Stadium open?**

The gates through which the relatives can enter the stadium from the arrival level will be open from 2 PM.

**26. Who can accompany graduating students to the event? How many relatives, family members, friends can attend?**

Students may be accompanied by family members, friends, acquaintances, anyone they wish. The number of people accompanying them is not limited.

**27. Where can I park during the event?**

Around the Nagyerdei Stadium we suggest parking on Nagyerdei körút, Ady Endre út, Pallagi út and in the area of the Clinics. We recommend the use of public transportation in the case of participants from Debrecen.

**28. How can people with reduced mobility enter the Stadium?**

On the elevated sidewalk leading to the Stadium or by using the glass elevator located at the southwestern elevated sidewalk.

**29. Are there any objects that cannot be taken inside the stadium (drinks, umbrella, etc.)?**

It is forbidden to bring into the stadium knives or other bladed or pointed items which may be used to hurt other people.

**24. Will there be a cloakroom available in the Stadium?**

No.

**25. When does the event start and end exactly?**

The event starts at 4 PM and is expected to end at 5 PM.

**26. Where can we buy food/drinks during the event?**

The service units are located on the arrival level of the Nagyerdei Stadium.

**27. Where is the University Gift Shop located if we would like to buy university souvenirs?**

The stands of the University Gift Shop are located on the arrival level of the Nagyerdei Stadium.

**28. Can relatives enter the VIP stands after the event to meet the graduating students?**

No. At the end of the ceremony all graduating students need to leave the area of the VIP stands.

**30. Where can I find the emergency ambulance during the event?**

There will be two ambulance cars present at the event. One will be located in the north-western passage of the stadium (to the right of the entrance of HALL), the other one close to the VIP entrance.

**31. Will there be a professional photographer from whom we can buy photographs?**

The photos taken by the University Press Office will be available in the photo gallery of the unideb.hu website. Moreover, the UD students' union provides opportunities for taking photos with professionals in front of a photo wall at several venues, next to the stadium and also at the water tower.
