From 1949 to 1974 he was a competitor member and the Head of the Athletic Department of DEAC (The Athletic Club of the University of Debrecen). He became a certified specialist in oto-rhino-laryngology in 1952. Between 1949 and 1973 he was a qualified consulting physician at the DOTE's Paediatric Clinic. From 1956 until 1973 he had been the sole bronchologist for normally and prematurely born babies in Eastern Hungary and Tiszántúl region. He organized the opening of the Clinic of Infant Otorhinolaryngology, Debrecen in 1973. After 1974 he practised as an appointed Chief Physician at the Department of Otorhinolaryngology in the Municipal Hospital of Kecskemét. From 1986 until his retirement in 1988 he functioned as a governmental commissary.

István Samu, M.D., Chief Physician:

He graduated in medicine in 1950, with *summa cum laude* qualification. After graduation he worked as an extern in the Clinic of Neurology, Psychiatry and Neurosurgery in Debrecen. In 1957 he became a Chief Physician at the Department of Male Neurology and Psychiatry in the Hospital of Balassagyarmat. He worked as a Chief Physician and the Head of the Department of Psychiatry in the Hospital of Berettyóújfalu. Afterwards, he got appointed as the Chief Physician and the Head of the Department of Psychiatric Crisis Intervention and Alcohol Detoxification in the Hospital of Salgótarján, where he worked on until his retirement in 1983. After his retirement he kept on practising as a specialist psychiatrist until 2008.

Gyula Tar, M.D., Medical Specialist:

He graduated in medicine in 1950. After graduation he started his career at the Department of Internal Medicine, in the Municipal Hospital of Nyíregyháza. He became a certified specialist in internal medicine in 1955. In 1959 he moved to Dunántúl, where he practised as an internal specialist. Due to political reasons in the mid 70s he was relegated and became an industrial physician but in the same field of speciality. In 1980 he became a certified specialist in industrial health care. In the early 90s he achieved considerable scientific results in the industrial medicine. He remained active in his profession until the age of 75.

Ms Ilona Tóth, M.D., Chief Physician:

She graduated in medicine in 1950, after which she worked in the Municipal Hospital of Sátoraljaújhely between 1951 and 1958. In 1955 she became a certified specialist in laboratory techniques. She worked as an Assistant Lecturer in the DOTE's Public Health Institute from 1958 until 1960. Later she functioned as a Chief Physician in the Medical Laboratory of the Health Service of MÁV until 1978.

Pál Török, M.D., Ph.D., Chief Physician, Titular Associate Professor:

He graduated in medicine in 1950. Prof. Kálmán Sántha, the Director of the Clinic of Neurology, Psychiatry and Neurosurgery in Debrecen employed him as an extern in 1949. He worked there as a demonstrator until 1964, and later as medical apprentice. He was promoted to Clinical Assistant Lecturer then to Senior Lecturer. He became a certified specialist in neurology, neurosurgery and psychiatry. He actively functioned in all these fields, but practised mainly as a neurosurgeon. From 1964 until his retirement in 1990 he was a Chief Physician and the Head of the Department of Neurology and Neurosurgery in the Municipal Hospital of Miskolc. The University Medical School of Debrecen honoured him with Titular Associate Professorship in 1983. Since his retirement he has been still active in the field of neurology, presently as a practising psychiatrist.

Géza Várady, M.D., Director General:

He graduated in medicine in 1950. After receiving his medical diploma, he specialized in neurology and psychiatry at prof. Kálmán Sántha's clinic. In 1951 he got enlisted in the national army. He was first assigned to the country's only parachute troop, but later was reassigned to the Department of Neurology and Neurosurgery of the Central Military Hospital, Budapest. He was discharged in 1957. He stayed in Budapest, and for the next three decades he functioned as the Director of the capital's neurological institutes and as the neurological, psychiatric and alcoholological Inspector General Chief Physician of the capital. Later he became the director of a functional mental hygienic institute in Buda. After his retirement he practised in forensic medicine, as a mental specialist.

4.2. Honoris Causa Doctors

Dr. Yehuda Shoenfeld is the head of the Department of Medicine since 1984 (age 36), and he has founded and is heading the Center for Autoimmune Diseases since 1985 - at the largest hospital in Israel- the Sheba Medical Center, which is affiliated to the Sackler Faculty of Medicine in Tel-Aviv University. Dr. Shoenfeld is the Incumbent of the Laura Schwarz-Kipp Chair for Research of Autoimmune Diseases in Tel-Aviv University.

His clinical and scientific works focus on autoimmune /rheumatic diseases, and he has published more than 1450 papers in journals such as New Eng J Med, Lancet, Proc Nat Acad Scie, J Clin Invest, J Immunol, Blood, J Exp Med, Circulation, Cancer and others. His articles had over 15,000 citations until 2007. He has authored and edited 10 books, some of which became cornerstones in science and clinical practice, such as "The Mosaic of Autoimmunity", "Infections and Autoimmunity" and the textbook "Autoantibodies" all of which were published by Elsevier and sold by the thousands. He is on the editorial board of 43 journals in the field of rheumatology, and autoimmunity and is the founder and the editor of the IMAJ (Israel Medical Association Journal) the representative journal of science and medicine in the English language in Israel and also is the founder and Editor of the Autoimmunity Reviews (Elsevier). He has written more than one hundred chapters in books.

Dr. Shoenfeld received in Vienna, Austria, the EULAR prize 2005: "The infectious etiology of anti-phospholipid syndrome. He has received a gold medal from the Slovak Society of Physicians for his contribution to Israel – Slovakia collaboration (March 2006), and is honorary member of the Hungarian Association of Rheumatology. In UC Davis, USA Dr. Shoenfeld received the Nelson's Prize for Humanity and Science for 2008

Dr. Shoenfeld has educated a long list of students being heads of departments and institutes.

4.3. The Debrecen Award for Molecular Medicine

In 2009, **Prof. Axel Ullrich** (Harvard University, USA) was honored by the *Debrecen Award for Molecular Medicine*.

Axel Ullrich born October 19, 1943, Lauban, Schlesien, is a German cancer researcher and has been the Director of Molecular Biology at the Max Planck Institute of Biochemistry in Martinsried, Germany since 1988. His research has primarily focused on signal transduction. After taking a degree in biochemistry at the University of Tübingen, Germany, he received a Ph.D. from the University of Heidelberg in Molecular Genetics in 1975. He then did his postdoctoral work at the University of California, San Francisco from 1975 to 1977 and then worked as a senior scientist at Genentech in San Francisco, California from 1978 to 1988. Since 1988, Prof. Ullrich has been Director of the Department of Molecular Biology at the Max-Planck-Institute of Biochemistry in Martinsried (Germany) and currently he is a visiting scientist at the Institute of Molecular and Cell Biology in Singapore and Research Director of the Singapore Onco Genome Project. He is an Honorary Professor of the

Second Military Medical University (Shanghai, China) and the University of Tübingen and elected member of the European Molecular Biology Organization, the German Academy of Natural Scientists "Leopoldina" and the American Academy of Arts and Sciences.

His work in the field of signal transduction research has elucidated major fundamental molecular mechanisms that govern the physiology of normal cells and allowed insights into pathophysiological mechanisms of major human diseases. For over 25 years Prof. Ullrich has been a leader in gene technology, translating basic science discoveries into medical applications. This led in the eighties to the development of **Humulin** (human Insulin for the treatment of diabetes; Lilly), the first therapeutic agent to be developed through gene-based technology and the first biotechnology product ever. Another biotechnology product that is based on Prof. Ullrich's work is Trastuzumab (trade name: **Herceptin**), the first target-directed, gene-based cancer therapy for the treatment of metastatic breast carcinoma (Genentech/Roche). Prof. Ullrich's work has also led to the development of the multi-targeted drug **SU11248/SUTENT** which has successfully passed Phase III clinical trials and was submitted to the FDA for approval (Pfizer) as a cancer therapeutic.

Among other honours and awards, Prof. Ullrich received the Robert Koch Prize, the Bruce F. Cain Memorial Award of the American Association of Cancer Research and the King Faisal Prize of Medicine. His major contributions to Science have led to his being appointed to advisory boards of internationally renowned institutions such as the Wistar Institute (USA), the Biomedicum (Finland), the Max-Delbrück-Center for Molecular Medicine (Germany) and the International Advisory Council of the EDB (Singapore). His scientific work has been published in more than 450 articles in international journals and with over **58,000 citations he is one of the ten most cited scientists over the past 25 years worldwide**. He is listed by the Institute for Scientific Information (ISI) as a highly cited biologist and he is also in the **top ten of H-index of living biologists**. In 2001, Time Magazine Europe **has named Dr. Ullrich as one of 25 "tech leaders who are changing how we work, live and play"**.

Prof. Ullrich has been a leader in international biotechnology development with activities stretching from Germany, to the USA, Singapore and Australia. He is a founder of three biotechnology companies - SUGEN Inc. (USA), Axxima Pharmaceuticals AG (Germany) and U3 Pharma AG (Germany). In addition he has served on numerous Boards of Directors and Science Advisory Boards of biotechnology companies including SUGEN Inc. (USA), BioImage (Denmark), Bionomics (Australia), Cryptome Pharmaceuticals (Australia) and S*Bio (Singapore), and the pharmaceutical company Boehringer Ingelheim (Germany). Since 2000 he is a Biotech Advisor of the Economic Development Board of the Singapore Government. Moreover, he is a founding member of the Bavarian Biotech Management Company Bio^M.
