



The Central European-American Business Leaders Scholarship (Hungary)

The objective of this program is to provide Hungary's future business leaders with substantive work experience at American businesses as well as an American-based MBA.



The key benefits of the program include:

- Scholars gain up to two years of work experience at American businesses.
- During MBA studies, work part-time at American businesses.
- After completing their MBA, work full-time at American businesses.
- All scholars earn an MBA at Quinnipiac University.
- At the conclusion of the program, students are required to return to Hungary, putting their knowledge and experience to use.

The scholarship includes:

- One reasonably priced economy class roundtrip airline ticket.
- A start-up stipend to help with initial living and travel costs.
- A room in university housing (first year) and health insurance during MBA studies.
- Fully paid tuition.
