## Teaching activity

I started taking part in teaching as a law student. In the academic year of 1991/1992 I took part in the activity of the Scientific Student Circle (TDK) organized by the Institution of Civil Sciences. I was a demonstrator at the Department of Civil Law from the academic year of 1992/1993 to receiving my diploma. In 1998 I became an assistant lecturer at the Department of Agricultural Law, Environmental Law and Labour Law where I am an associate professor now. One of my teaching tasks within the frames of teaching law students is educating the subject labour and social law, which takes three academic semesters and is closed by university examination for both regular and correspondent students. I note and teach this subject. In the administration basic education (BA) I also note the subject labour law of public service.

I take part in post-gradual education and I am responsible for the subject labour law in educating health specialists and economic specialists with legal professional certificate. I am also responsible for post-gradual education for human resources managers.

Our Department offers a great choice of themes of thesis to the students and we urge independent initiations. I regularly consulat 6-8 theses per year and the similar number of university thesis each academic year. Within the frames of work in the scientific student circle I consulted the thesis of many talented students. My students have taken part successfully at the Conferences of the National Scientific Student Circle (OTDK) since 2001. At the Conference of the National Scientific Circle one of my students received first place award and three of my students received second place award. At the National Competition on Labour Law Pleadings among the Hungarian faculties of law several of my students have received first place award so far.

## Research experiences

Scientific research activity is an organic part of my higher educational tasks. After completing my doctoral dissertation I returned to my original research field, namely, the detrimental consequences, mainly the examination of labour law liability.

My scientific results have appeared in 52 publications so far. I took part in completing 7 books, workbooks, and lecture notes. In 2009 my monograph entitled „*The basic questions of the employment relationships of lecturers and researchers in higher education*” came out, and on behalf of the Wolters Kluwer Complex Kft. Publisher. I took part in completing the Commentary and Explanation (DVD) on the law about judicial enforcement. Together with my colleagues at our Department in 2011 we completed the Commentary of act XXII of 1992 on the Labour Code on behalf of the Opten Informatics Kft. Publisher and then in 2012 we were commissioned to make Commentary of the (new) act I of 2012 on the Labour Code. Taking into consideration the changes and at present we are working on it to be published. In 2014 the co-author Professor Tamás Prugberger we published the book “*European and Hungarian Comparative Labour and Public Service Law*” on behalf of the Complex Wolters Kluwer Publisher.

Besides other eminent lecturers I am a regular lecturer at the Hungarian Labour Law Conference, which always deals with different subjects and is held at Visegrád. I also represent the University of Debrecen Faculty of Law at other professional conferences. On the one hand I intend to get to know and use the latest scientific results and on the other hand I try to cover them in my teaching activity.

### **Professional public activity**

In 2006 I was appointed to the educational manager of the Faculty of Law till July 30 2009. I took part in preparing the curriculum for basic and master education. I was active in schooling programme that resulted growing number in enrolment. I developed sample curriculums, which were the basis of education.

To 2010 I was the secretary and to 2014 the president of the Educational Board of the Bar of Debrecen. This way as a practical jurist I took part in organizing education from the side of legal application.

On the 1<sup>st</sup> September 2003 I was appointed to the censor at bar examination by the Minister of Justice and since then I am an active participant in the jurists’ professional post-graduate education.

Between 2005 and 2010 I was member of the Office of the Hungarian Labour Law and Arbitration, which is the institution of labour law mediation and which members are appointed to by the National Consultation Committee.

From September 2006 I have been a member of the Society of Hungarian Labour Law what is the Hungarian labour law jurists’ scientific workshop.

I am a member of the editorial board of the e-journal Hungarian Labour Law.

In 2014 the Minister of Justice offered me a membership in the professional group, which reviews the situation of the labour law judging practice.
