I inform you that the Senate has finalized the dates for the faculties' graduation ceremonies. Accordingly, the Faculty of Humanities will hold its **formal GRADUATION CEREMONIES on Thursday, July 2, 2026**, in the **Main Building's Courtyard (Díszudvar)**, according to the following schedule*:

- **starting at 10:00 a.m.**, students in **the full-time undergraduate program (BA)** will receive their diplomas, with the **exception of students in the undergraduate psychology program**,

(rehearsal: Tuesday, June 30, 10:00 a.m., Courtyard (Díszudvar)),

- **starting at 1:00 p.m.**, students in the **full-time undivided teacher training program (OMA)** and the **disciplinary master's program (MA)** will receive their diplomas,

(rehearsal: Tuesday, June 30, 12:00 p.m., Courtyard (Díszudvar)),

- **starting at 4:00 p.m.**, students in **the full-time undergraduate psychology program**, as well as students in the **part-time undergraduate (BA), master's (MA)**, and **postgraduate specialized training courses (SI, SV)** programs will receive their diplomas

(rehearsal: Tuesday, June 30, 2:00 p.m., Courtyard (Díszudvar)).

Please note that at the graduation ceremony, diplomas will be awarded to graduates who

- have successfully passed the final exam **and**
- attend (in person or through an authorized representative) the rehearsal for the graduation ceremony, **and**
- have no outstanding obligations to the Faculty or the University.

Further details regarding the graduation ceremony will be provided after the end of the final exam period.
