

Information on State Exam for Dentistry Students_2 0 2 2

Date and time of the state exam: 20 June, 2022, 9:00am

Place of the state exam: University of Debrecen, Life Science Building – 003/004

The test questions are based on integrated dental knowledge obtained in undergraduate dentistry training. The test questions have been revised, and the revised test questions are used from this year. Each question has a single best choice answer. Candidates get the same test questions in the Hungarian and English language training programs.

Preparing for the exam

The website www.zarovizsga.hu contains test questions and the answers to that questions to help students prepare for the state exam. The state exam is going to consist of the same questions or questions similar to such questions.

Students may take practice exams. There are three types of practice exams:

- Short exam: Students may complete a test containing questions belonging to three topics of their choice. This test consists of 50 questions. The duration of the exam is 45 minutes.
- Long exam: Students may complete a test containing questions belonging to three topics of their choice. The exam consists of 180 questions. The duration of the exam is 180 minutes.
- Practice exam: Students may complete a test that contains questions from all topics. The exam consists of 180 questions. The duration of the exam is 180 minutes.

Course of the exam

Arrival: **8:15am**

Duration of the exam: **180 min. 9:00am – 12:00pm**

Number of test questions: **180**

Candidates may enter the examination hall after presenting a valid photo card for identification and signing the attendance sheet. The exam supervisors and the employees of the Dean's Office present inform candidates of what they need to know before test writing.

The senior exam supervisor keeps a record of the written part of the state exam.

Candidates are not allowed to take any electronic device (mobile phone, laptop etc.) or any kind of hand-written or printed materials (notes, test books) to the examination hall. By signing the attendance sheet candidates declare that they comply with this rule.

The occupation of seats (seating arrangements) is determined by the exam supervisors.

Before the exam, candidates receive exam packages that contain an information sheet, a data sheet, an answer sheet consisting of two pages, and a test booklet. All students get the same questions with the order of the answer options being different. The letter of the answer candidates consider best must be ticked on the answer sheet clearly, **with a blue ball pen. Boxes left blank or where more than one answer is indicated are considered to be wrong answers.**

Only one candidate may leave the examination hall at a time, subject to the prior approval of the senior exam supervisor. The exact time of when a candidate leaves and returns to the examination hall must be duly recorded in the record of the written part of the state exam.

The state exam of candidates who use any kind of prohibited device, including any kind of electronic or smart device, is suspended by the supervisors with immediate effect without prior warning. The candidate whose state exam (the written part of the state exam) is suspended fails the written part of the exam. The fact of suspension must be recorded in the record of the written part of the state exam. The candidate whose exam is suspended will be subjected to disciplinary procedure.

Candidates may leave the examination hall only in justified cases and subject to the permission of the senior exam supervisor. Only one student may be absent from the examination hall at a time. The exact time of when the student leaves and returns to the examination hall must be recorded on the test booklet, signed by the senior exam supervisor.

Exam results

The result, not yet official, will be available in the website www.zarovizsga.hu for five days after the tests are marked, but after not later than 12:00pm on the day following the exam. Students may access the results after entering their respective personal user identification and password indicated in the information sheet.

Marking

The grading thresholds will be determined, on the basis of the test results of the candidates of all four faculties of Dentistry of Hungary, based on the consensual decision of the representatives of the four faculties of Dentistry of Hungary.

Legal remedy

Observations may be made for 45 days, from day 75 to day 30, before the day of the written part of the state exam (day 0).

The system closes 30 days before the day of the written part of the state exam (day 0), and observations no longer can be made. However, the practice exam platform will be available to candidates even after that.

Observations, if any, will be examined and if considered well-founded, the questions/answers will be corrected.

Candidates may submit objections to certain questions of the state exam test in the website www.zarovizsga.hu until 6:00pm on the day of the written part of the state exam. Only technical objections may be made this time!

Candidates may object to the marking of certain questions in the website www.zarovizsga.hu, entering their personal user identification and password, until 4:00pm following the day of the paper based exam.

The right to legal remedy concerning the state exam is provided by Act CCIV of 2011 on National Higher Education.
